New Business

Externally Funded Projects

Trustee Alicea introduced Anastasia Urtz, Provost & Senior Vice President, who, in turn, introduced Nicole Schlater, Associate Vice President, Grants Administration. Ms. Schlater began her presentation with an update on externally funded projects on campus. She discussed financial constraints, the difference between grants v. gifts to the college, and partnerships. Grants are organized into categories and those include: direct support programs and services; program development, improvement and innovation; instructional design and delivery; capacity building, institutional learning, and organizational change; and partnerships and systems change. Ms. Schlater highlighted some major projects, including those recently concluded as well as those currently in progress. She then reviewed proposals in development and summer projects that the Grants office is working on. These include aligning the grants calendar to the new Strategic Plan; policy and procedure updates to align with US Department of Labor subawards; preparation for the Grants office administrative self-study; and integrating additional support for current projects.

Ms. Schlater continued her report with an update on the Institutional Review Board. She provided a brief overview of its purpose and responsibility and the process by which projects are submitted for review. She then discussed the proposals from 2023-24 and the planning process for 2024-25.
